RSSearch Registry is:

A worldwide, multi-platform research and data sharing registry aimed at:

- Generating peer reviewed publications
- Providing participants access to data to improve quality of care and medical decision making
- Fostering development of the science and practice of SRS/SBRT

Includes:

- Utilization, treatment and outcomes data
- Capable of recording data for all SRS/SBRT platforms
- Access to participants own data and select aggregate comparative data
- An easy to use, secure web-based application, both HIPAA and EU compliant

Features:

- Easy, comprehensive and flexible report generation
- Ability to customize database to meet individual site needs
- Opportunity for collaborative publication and research, coordinated through the RSS
- Access to all aggregate data via research application process
- Listed on ClinicalTrials.gov

RSSearch Registry History:

- Formally, the ReCKord™ CyberKnife Registry, launched in 2007
- To date, >11,000 patients entered and increasing monthly

Participation Requirements:

- Primary Investigator must be an RSS member
- RSSearch protocol submitted and approved by IRB or Ethics Committee
- Annual participation fee will be necessary in 2013 to cover registry maintenance costs

Step 2: Forward a copy of the IRB approval letter to the RSS and submit payment
